1. **General Information**

The protection of your personal data is very important to us.

We handle your data in accordance with the applicable data protection laws, in particular the **EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)**.

This Privacy Policy explains what information we collect, how it is used, and what rights you have.

2. **Website Hosting**

This website is hosted by *HostingProvider*.

When you visit our website, certain data is automatically collected and temporarily stored in server log files, including:

- a. IP address of the accessing device
- b. Browser type and version
- c. Date and time of access
- d. The page(s) visited

These data are used solely to ensure the technical operation and security of the website and are deleted automatically after a short period.

No personal analysis or tracking takes place.

3. **Contact**

If you contact us by email, we will store and process the information you provide (such as your name, email address, and message) solely for the purpose of handling your inquiry.

Your data will not be shared with third parties without your consent and will be deleted once your request has been fully processed, unless legal obligations require longer retention.

4. **Downloads**

When you download files (e.g., the project portfolio PDF), technical data such as your IP address, time of download, and browser type may be automatically processed by the hosting system to enable the download.

These data are not used for any further purpose and are deleted automatically after a short time.

5. **Cookies and Tracking**

This website **does not use cookies**, tracking technologies, analytics tools, or social media plugins.

6. Data Security

Appropriate technical and organizational measures are in place to protect your personal data against unauthorized access, loss, or misuse.

7. Your rights

According to the GDPR, you have the following rights:
